Gakuen is a sub-organization of the East San Gabriel Valley Japanese Community Center, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. We rely on family collaboration, community support, and fundraising efforts to help Gakuen maintain affordable tuition fees for families, purchase equipment and materials that directly support students' Japanese language education development, and to offset rising costs.

Every Gakuen family is asked to volunteer a minimum of three (3) fundraising events and four (4) yard/snack duties per school year. Families interested in volunteering more hours would be greatly appreciated. Should a family not be able to fulfill its volunteer commitments, the family shall forfeit the volunteer service deposit for that school year and place a new deposit of \$100 during registration for the following school year.

About fundraising events:

For the 2018-2019 school year, fundraising events for which parents and families may volunteer are: *Akimatsuri*, ESGVJCC Health Fair, *Mochitsuki*, Cherry Blossom Festival and Gakuen Pancake Breakfast.

About Yard/snack duty:

During yard/snack duty, families are asked to sell snacks during the first two breaks, help with special snacks/fundraisers scheduled for that day, and/or prepare for upcoming events.
